### NEW COMPETENCIES AND KUPs OF THE SHIP SECURITY OFFICER IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE 2010 STCW MANILA AMENDMENTS

Competence	Knowledge, Understanding and Proficiency
Maintain and supervise the implementation of a ship security plan	❖ Inclusion of “Elements that may relate to piracy and armed robbery”, in the different KUP’s under this competence
Assess security risk, threat and vulnerability	❖ Knowledge of techniques used to circumvent security measures, including those used by pirates and armed robbers.
Ensure that security equipment and systems, if any, are properly operated, tested and calibrated	❖ Knowledge of the various types of security equipment and systems and their limitations, including that could be used in case of attacks by pirates and armed robbers.
Encourage security awareness and vigilance	❖ Knowledge of training, drill and exercise requirements under relevant Conventions, Codes and IMO Circulars, including those relevant to anti-piracy and anti-armed robbery.
