Pursuant to Republic Act No. 10635 and its Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR), the 1978 International Convention on Standards of Training, Certification and Watchkeeping (STCW 78) for Seafarers, as amended, and for purposes of regularity and directions, all Certificates of Proficiency (COP) issued by this Authority under the following Regulations are **not subject to revalidation**:

Certificates of Proficiency (COP) for ancillary courses such as Basic Training (BT), Proficiency in Survival Craft and Rescue Boat (PSCRB), Proficiency in Fast Rescue Boat (PFRB), Advance Fire Fighting (AFF) and Medical First Aid (MEFA) issued by this Authority, however, are still subject to revalidation to ensure compliance to the competency requirements provided under STCW Convention, as amended.
